



HOW DOES MARINE LITTER AFFECT WILDLIFE & ECOSYSTEMS?

Alien species invasion

Some species hitch a ride on litter items and invade seas they would normally never reach. When these establish themselves in a new environment they interact with native species and pose threats to the biota and ecosystems. Alien species invasion is one of the most important threats to global biodiversity.

Damage of the benthic habitats

Litter in the sea can damage benthic habitats in many ways, through e.g. abrasion of coral reefs from fishing gear; disruption of colonies; disrupted oxygenation or 'smothering' of communities; etc.

Damage of the coastal habitats

The heavy machinery used to remove litter items from beaches damage the shore habitats.
